



## Sieda Community Action's 7 County Area 2010 to 2021 Census Data Collection

Appanoose, Davis, Jefferson, Keokuk, Mahaska, Van Buren, and Wapello Counties





## **Data Specific to Our Counties Poverty**

Sieda Community Action collects and reviews United States Census Bureau data for our core seven-county service. The survey program we use is the American Community Survey (ACS), 5-year Estimate. The Census data is collected each year from 2010 till 2020 (the current data).

We use several data tables to gather information about our lowa counties. The three primary sources are the

- DP05 (Demographic and Housing Estimates)
- S1701 (Poverty Status in the Past 12 Months)
- B17010 (Poverty Status in the Past 12 Months of Families by Family Type by Presence of Related Children Under 18 Years by Age of Related Children)

We compare yearly the numbers for our counties and lowa to see if there is increased or decreased since 2010. We use numbers of those above the 100% poverty line along side the numbers below the 100% poverty line and additional poverty levels.
